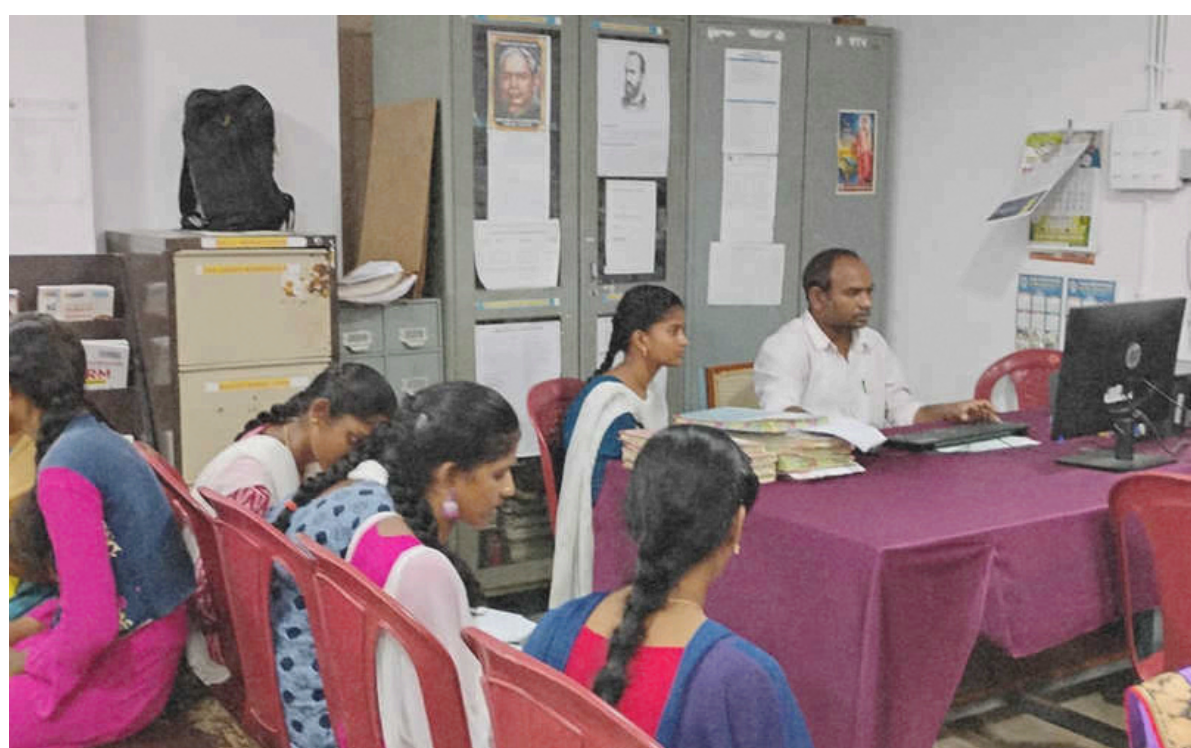
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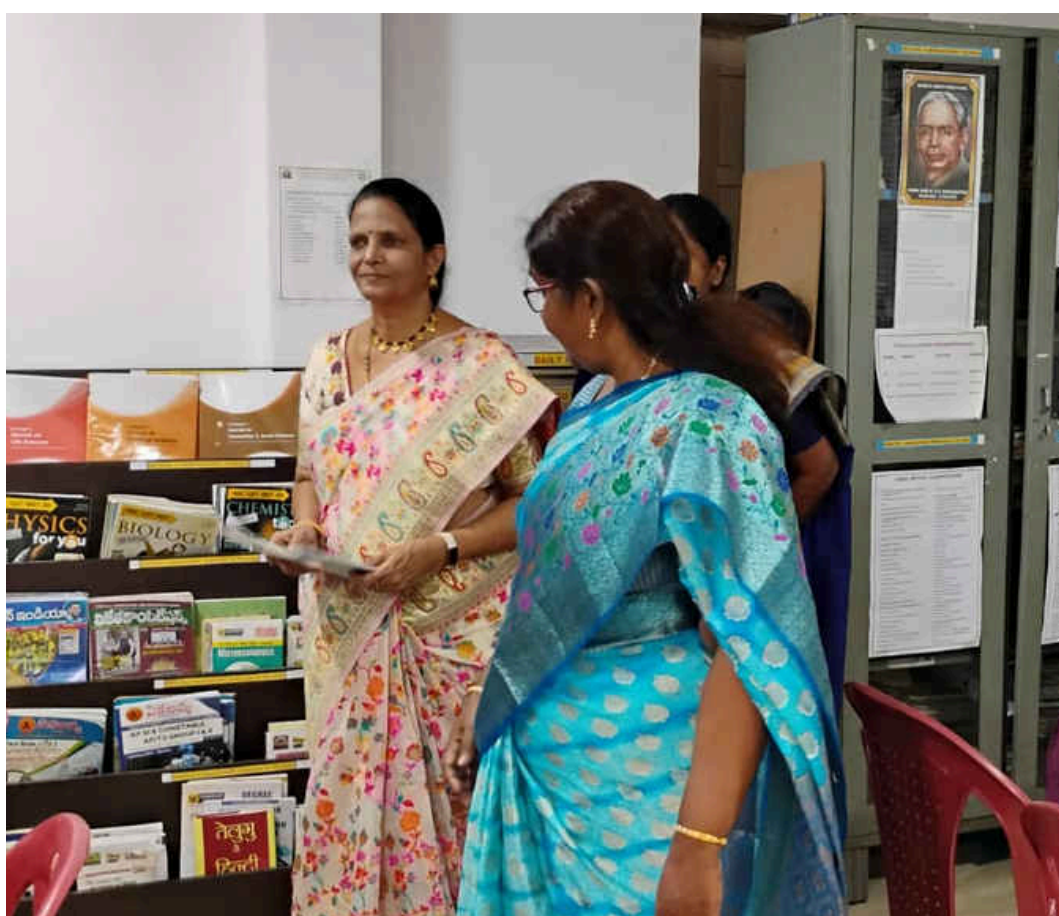
Free Registration and Guidance on admissions 2024-25

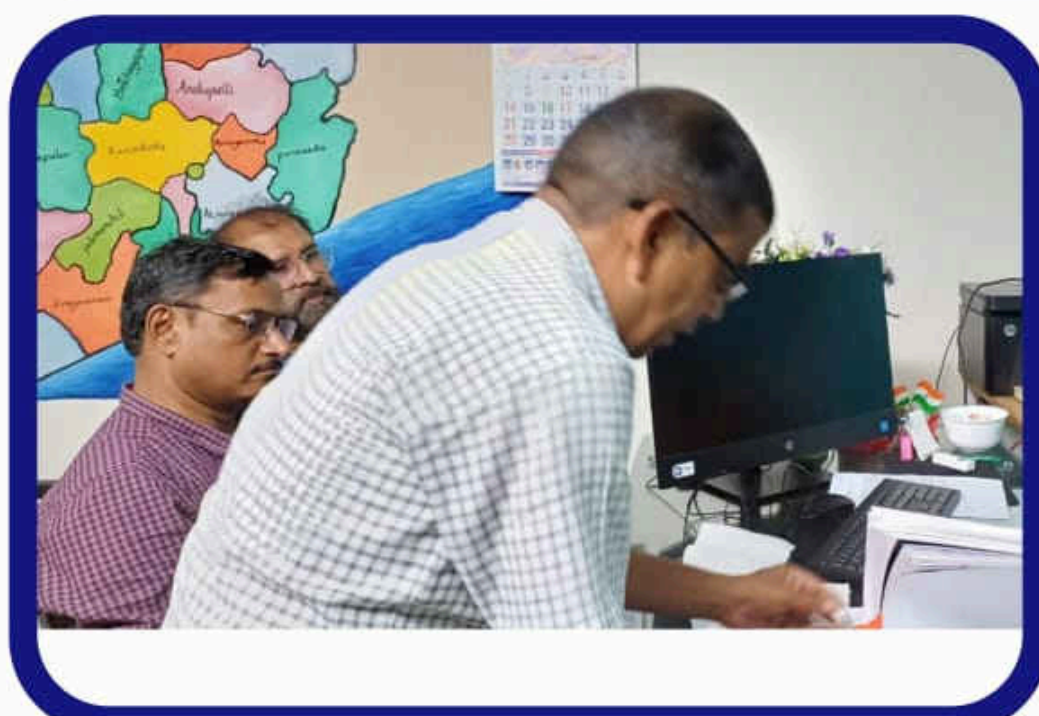
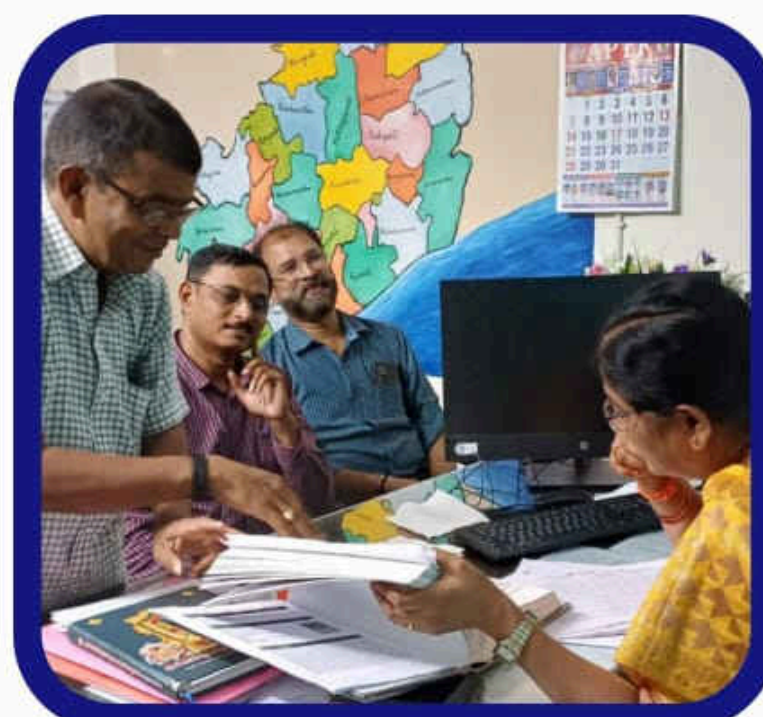
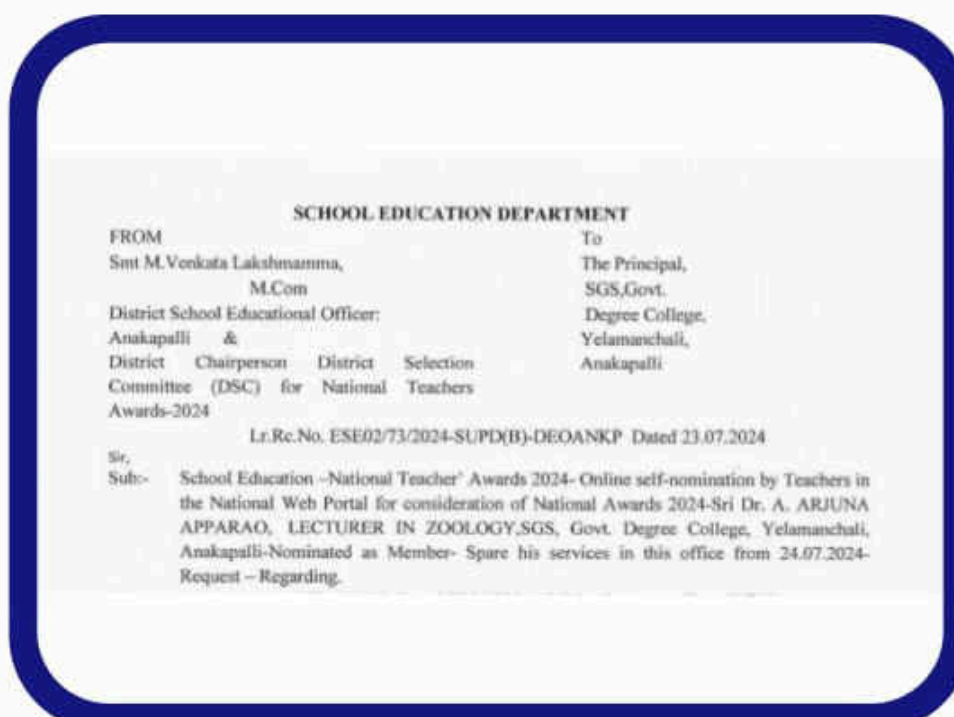
Library visit by faculty of different Government Degree Colleges
