CLAUSE-1

CO- OPERATION

- 1.1.  - 1.3. The general terms of cooperation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds, and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. CLAUSE -2

SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.3 Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its institution and also be involved in Training Programs for the First Party. The training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops /Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities including but not limited to efforts towards developing proposals for collaborative research, co-authoring publications, conducting joint research projects, or establishing joint research centers. etc.
- 2.5 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party one merging technologies to bridge the skill gap and make them industry-ready.
- 2.6 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest Lectures to the students of the First Party and vice-versa.

- 2.9 Cooperate to exchange information relating to their activities teaching and research fields of mutual interests; sharing best practices, sharing of E-content between the parties, and access to library and repository services, if possible.
- 2.10 Conduct cultural projects, and study tours, as mutually agreed by both parties.
- 2.11 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein
 - To promote and enhance academic, research interest between both parties
 - To provide summer training for UG and PG students during their course and provide professional manpower to support the programme.
 - Organizing and participating in joint Symposia/ Conferences/ Workshop/ Short term refresher courses.
 - This Memorandum of Understanding shall be valid from the date of signing of the same.

FUNDING:

Expenses for airfare, transportation, room and board and personal expenses of
exchange students, teachers or officers shall be covered by each individual. Students
will pay their registration, courses or professional practices at their home college, so
that they can be recognized afterwards.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid for THREE years from the date of execution of this agreement, and shall be automatically renewed thereafter for another three (3) years unless written notice to terminate or amend this agreement is given to the other party six (6) months in advance.
- 4.2 It is expressly agreed that neither party shall be liable for damages that they Might cause each other as a result of a forceful suspension of a collaboration program.
- 4.3Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIPBETWEENTHEPARTIES

It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this 5.1 MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

First Party Second Party

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at the District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed by Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Visakhapatnam.
