Launch of Short-Term Internship Programme at SGA Degree College

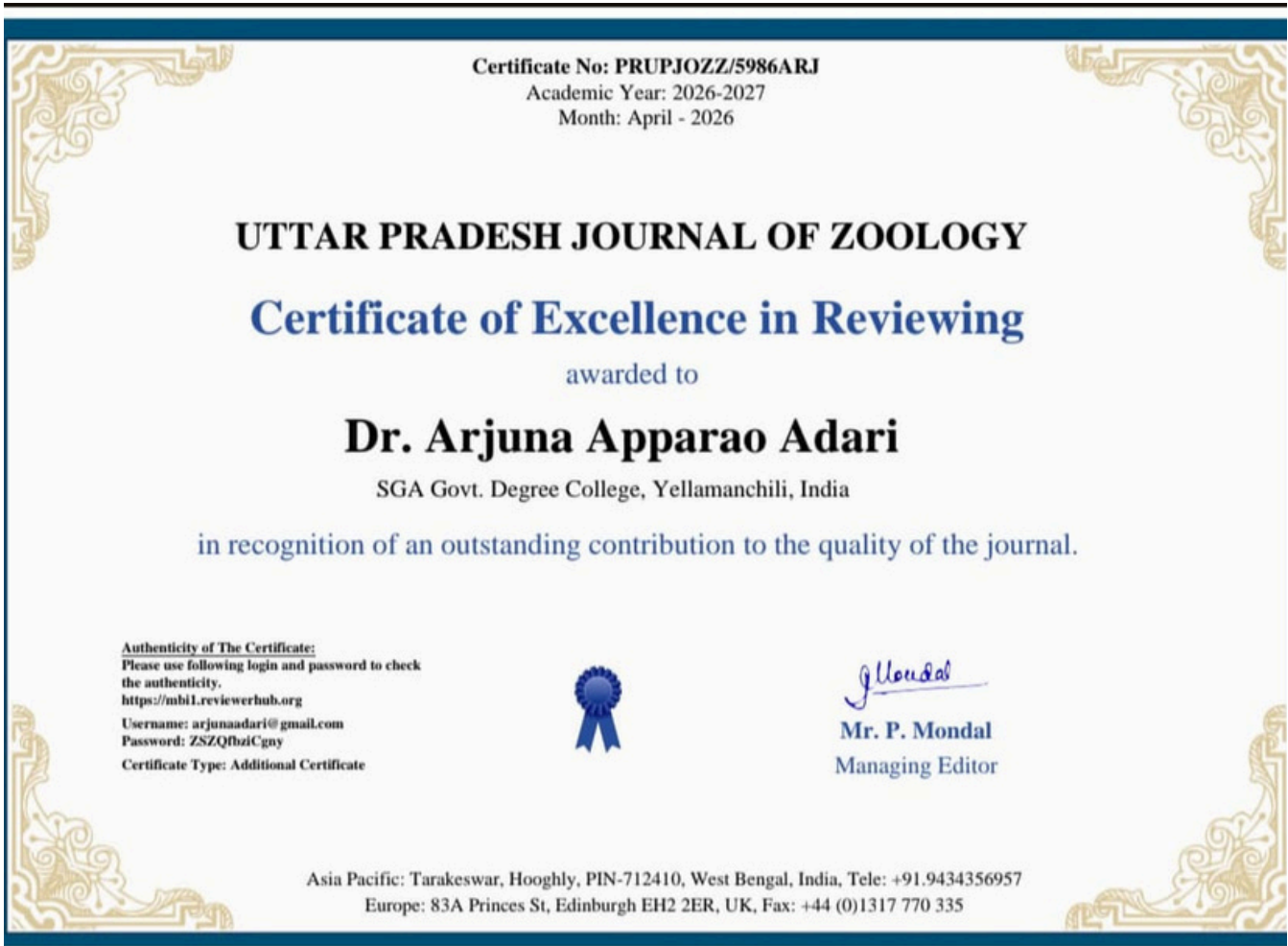

SGA Students Showcase Talent in Poster Presentation at GDC Palakonda

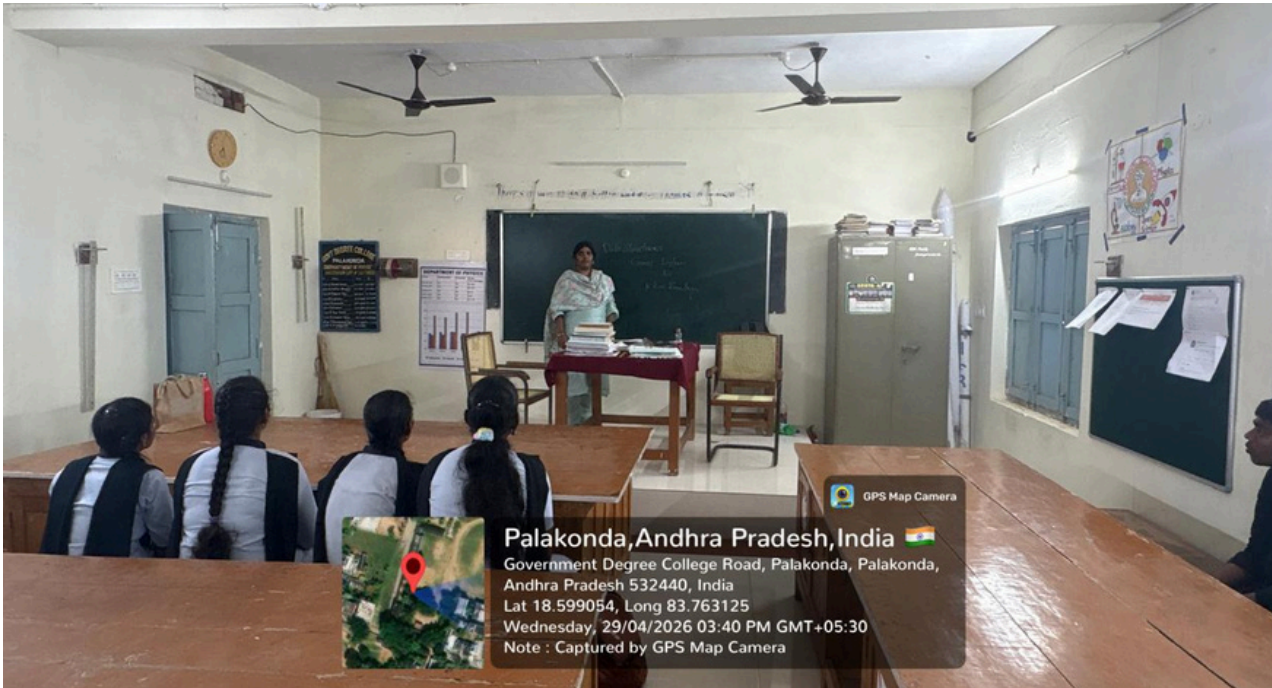
