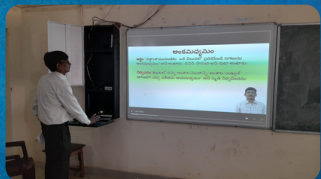

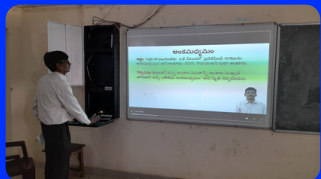

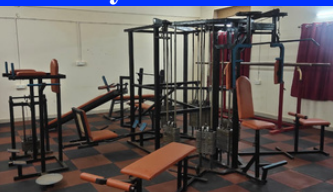

## Guest Lecture on Group Theory Delivered

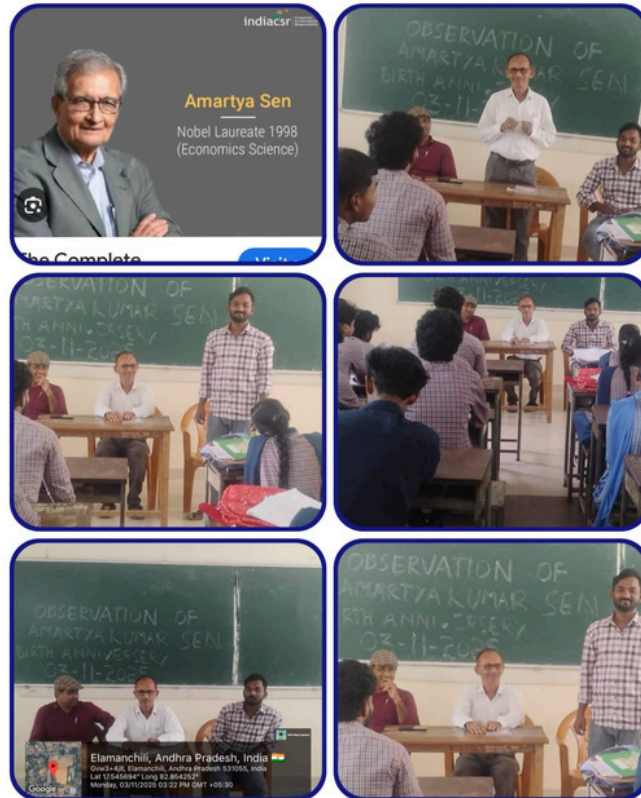
