The institution congratulates Ms. Rekha Ramarao for her active participation and successful completion of the quiz.



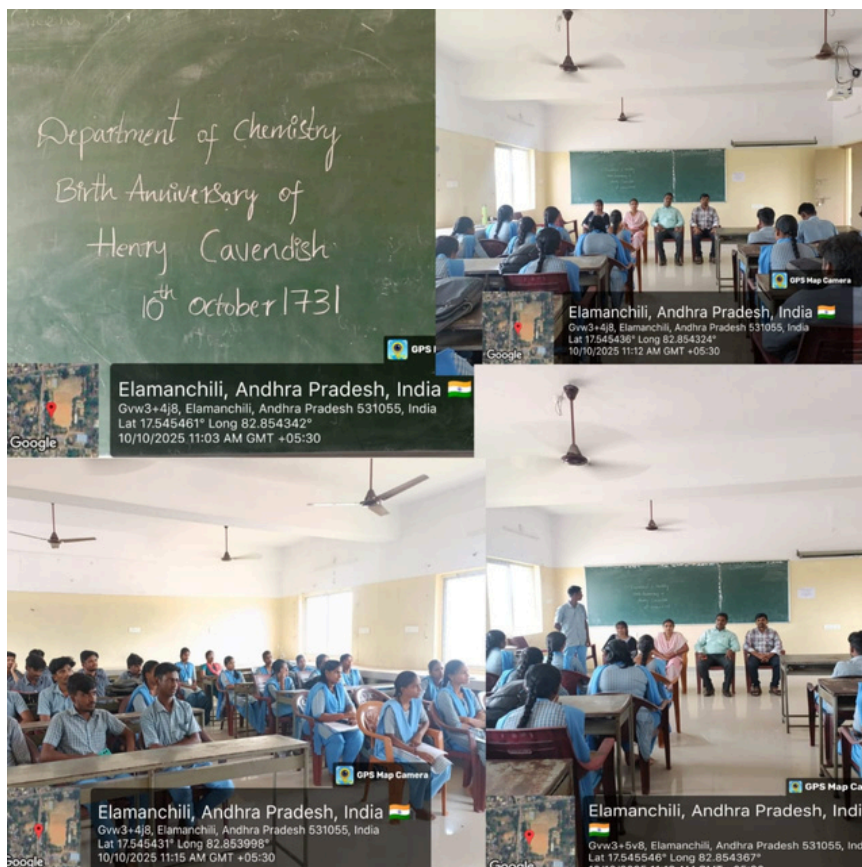
National Seminar on “Diverse Women’s Voices in Post-Independence Telugu–Hindi Literature”

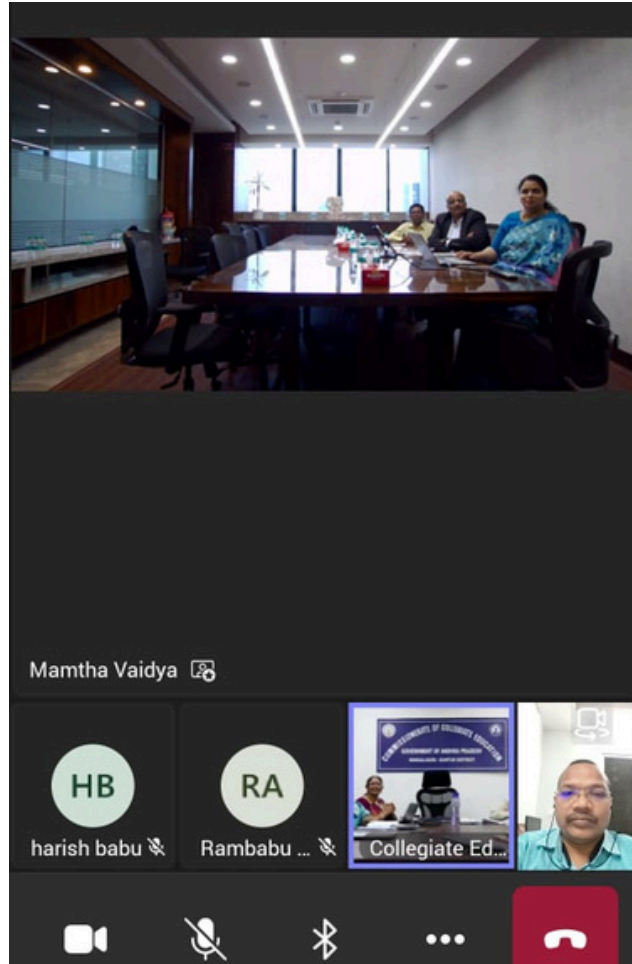
Seminar given by Dr. Lakshmi Mangamma, Resource person
